Project goals



- To put together information about maritime affairs
- Accessibility of the archival and library material to users
- Insight into the state of the material
- Protection of the archival and library material

Working methodology



- Direct insight into the archival and library material
- Selection and arrangement of material
- Description of material according to international library and archival standards

Project dynamics



- Project will be carried out in 4 stages, with total duration of at least 5 years
- The first stage covers: animation of CKPCG subjects; public presentation; presentations of the project in the media; field visits and insight into the state of the material, defining the network of associates; drafting methodological instruction; training of associates; programme of adequate measures for protection and saving material.
- For the first stage, it is approved the financial assistance of € 3.000 from Kotor Local Government.



Project evaluation



- CKPCG effects will reflect positively to the quality of services rendered by the Maritime Library
- CKPCG will supplement the education process at Kotor Maritime Faculty
- CKPCG will show the contribution of maritime affairs to total economic and social, and especially cultural development
- As a database, CKPCG will be compatible with other similar databases with us, in Europe and globally.
